- Women veterans experiencing homelessness is projected to increase by 9% by 2025.
- More than 30% of women veterans experiencing homelessness have experienced Military Sexual Trauma
- 40% of women veterans experiencing homelessness are between the ages of 40 and 60.





The VA provides a variety of services for veterans experiencing homelessness as well as those at-risk of homelessness.

The Health Care for Homeless Veterans program addresses the needs of chronically mentally ill homeless veterans. Services include alcohol and drug treatment, assistance with temporary housing and food, employment assistance, and the Veterans Justice Outreach program.
